Period	Sophia love playing hockey.	Question Mark	Are you hungry?
Comma	I like novel, stories, plays, and poems.	Exclamation Mark	Wow! What a lovely scene!
Colon	She like three counties: Italy, USA, and UAE.	Semicolon	I will not prefer cola; I will drink juice.
Braces	Choose one of three colors {red, pink, black}.	Parentheses	I love to visit UK (United Kingdom).
Dashes	USA-Japan is almost 13 hours long flight.	Brackets	She [Jenny] is crazy for driving a truck.
Hyphen	I love ice-cream.	Quotation Marks	Ali asked, "When can I put the pen back?"
Ellipsis	Julie... Julie is the girl who...	Apostrophe	Roger's dog is weak.

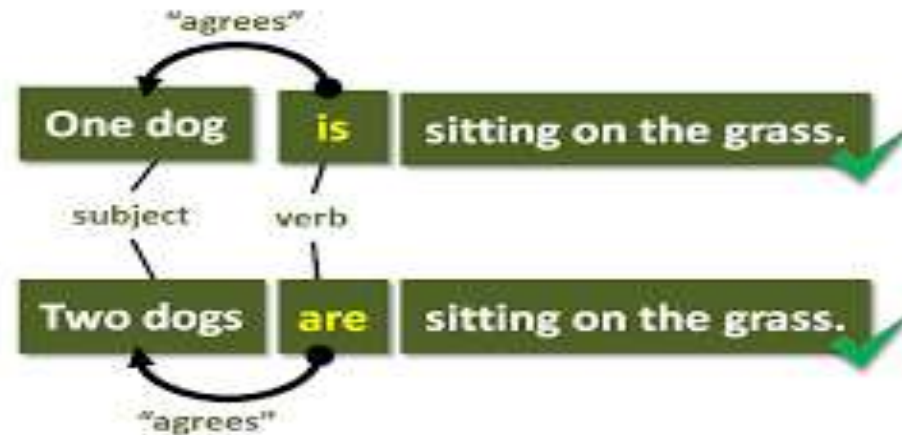
